Non Licensed Work training is a task specific, practical training course. It is aimed at those whose work will knowingly disturb asbestos containing materials (ACMs) such as maintenance workers and their supervisors. It is given in addition to asbestos awareness training, which by itself does not permit any work with any ACMs. The course content is fully compliant with the requirements of the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012 and HSE guidance: Asbestos Essentials (Task Manual).
