Building Surveying & Bulk Sampling for Asbestos



For those undertaking building surveys to identify asbestos, the BOHS P402 proficiency module is the minimum recognised qualification to carry out such work. The P402 provides the theoretical and practical knowledge in the surveying of buildings for asbestos and sampling of suspect materials.

The practical session covering bulk sampling ensures the candidates understand appropriate sampling strategies and how representative samples are obtained safely.

Day 1

- Introduction & legislative requirements
- Types & uses of asbestos in buildings
- Surveys of asbestos containing materials in buildings (ACMs)

Day 2

- Surveys of ACMs in buildings (cont)
- Risk assessments
- Management of ACMs in buildings

Day 3

- Practical assessment
- Walk through survey
- Bulk sampling
- Examination (supervised & marked by BOHS)

Candidates are assessed upon practical competence, culminating in a 45-question multiple choice examination (approx 1hr 15min duration). The exam is administered by the BOHS and, subject to successfully meeting further requirements of submission of two Type 2 or Type 3 surveys, leads to the attainment of the P402 certificate.
