Background

Being one of the largest Unitary Authorities in the UK, Staffordshire County Council are responsible for in excess of 3800 buildings ranging from less than 250m² to properties in excess of 16,000m² in size.

Project Details

Environmental Essentials were awarded the contract via a rigid tender process to carry out Type 2/Management Surveys to all sites. The surveys were carried out to a complex reporting method specified by the Council. All surveys were carried out and completed within budget and delivered to the timescales set within the contract.

In 2010 Environmental Essentials were also successful at gaining a place onto the Consultants Framework for air monitoring, refurbishment and demolition surveys and emergency works.
